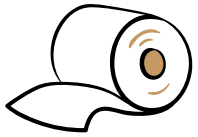

WATER CLOSET (WC)
POLITE

IN THE 1870S TOILETS WERE CALLED "WASH-DOWN CLOSETS"

THE WC EQUIVALENT


COMFORT ROOM (CR)
POLITE

FROM THE ARCHAIC WORD "DUNNEKIN", DUNG HOUSE


THE DUNNY

THE HEAD

IN THE 1700S, TOILETS WERE LOCATED AT THE BOW OF A SHIP

FROM THE LATIN WORD "LAVARE"

LAVATORY
VERY FORMAL



LATRINE

USED BY THE BRITISH ARMY. DERIVING FROM THE LATIN WORD "LAVARE"

IN THE LATE 1700S THE TOILET WAS CALLED THE BOG HOUSE

THE BOG
INFORMAL

KHAZY
OUTDATED

DERIVES FROM THE COCKNEY WORD "CARSEY", MEANING TOILET. IT CAN ALSO BE LINKED TO ITALIAN "CASA"

BACK TO MEDIEVAL EUROPE, WHEN CHAMBER POTS HAD TO BE EMPTIED FROM BEDROOM WINDOWS ONTO THE STREET BELOW, PEOPLE WOULD SCREAM OUT THE FRENCH PHRASE "GARDEZ L'EAU"

INFORMAL-POLITE


THE PRIVY
OUTDATED

COMING FROM "PRIVATE", MEANT A PRIVATE PLACE FOR SHARING SECRETS OR THOUGHTS

REFERS TO SIR JOHN HARRINGTON, THE INVENTOR OF THE FLUSHING TOILET IN THE 1500S
